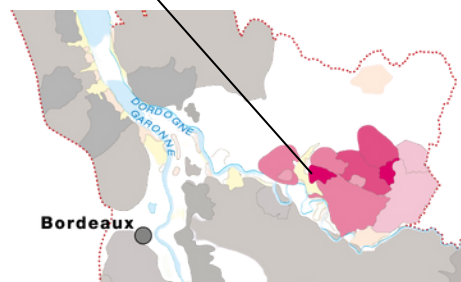


Château Moulinet
