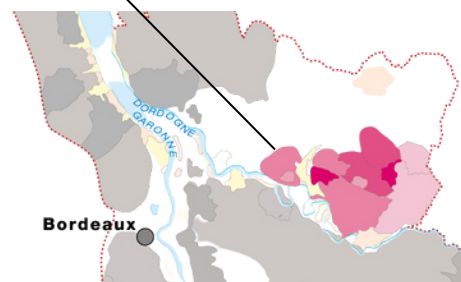


# Château Puy Guilhem

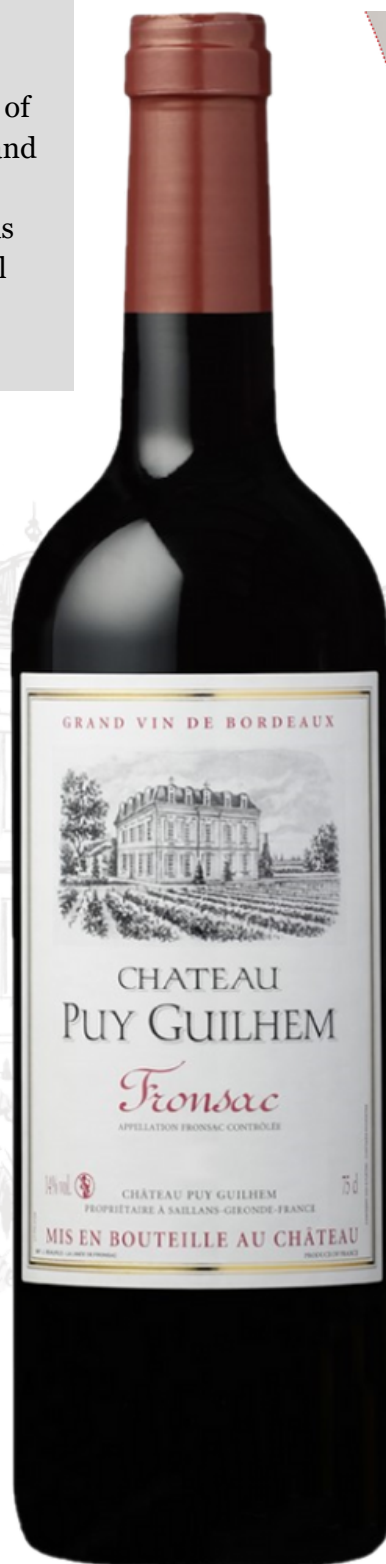
## 2010
