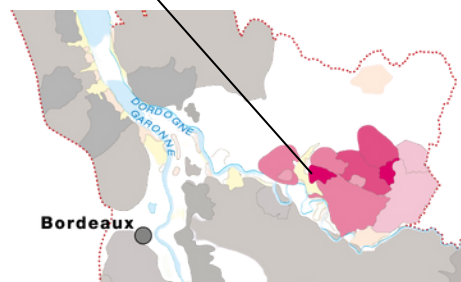


# Château Moulinet
