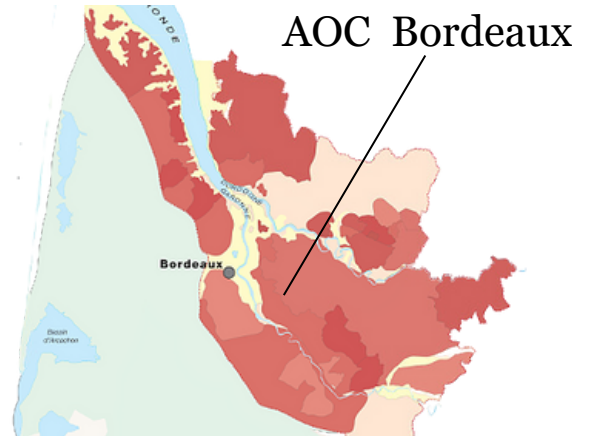


Château Plaisance

Tasting Notes:

The lively and refreshing palate offers a revitalizing experience, with a light to medium body that feels invigorating. Delicate notes of cranberries and raspberries dance on the tip of the tongue, while the subtle lingering hints of lime and citrus add an extra layer of complexity to the overall profile.
