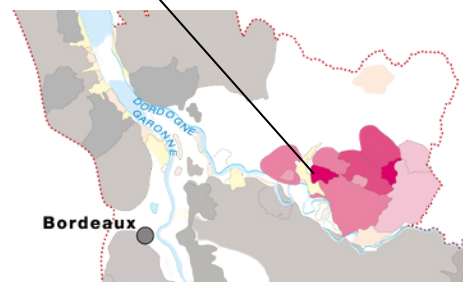

The tannins make a subtle presence only on the finish, allowing your palate to revel in the lusciousness of this mouthwatering wine for as long as possible. While it may need a few years to soften the finish, it will undoubtedly evolve into a delectable wine over time, satisfying enthusiasts of rounded, ripe, and velvety red wines.

Château Moulinet, located in the Pomerol appellation, a prestigious region on the right bank of Bordeaux, is one of the oldest vineyards in the area, with a history dating back to the Middle Ages. The vineyard is fully hand-harvested. While respecting traditional winemaking techniques, it strives for perfection and was one of the pioneers in Bordeaux to experiment with 'whole bunch fermentation'.
