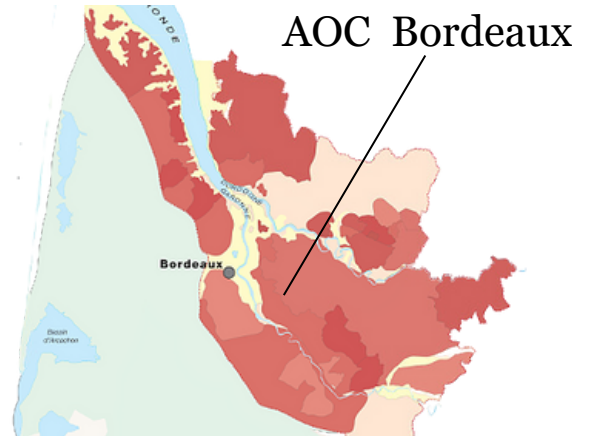


Château Plaisance
